Wisconsin State Debate Tournament Results Summary

Since the 2006-2007 school year, the WHSFA and WDCA have held the joint Wisconsin State Debate Tournament. The 2010-2011 edition is the fifth edition of the tournament, and featured independent tournament director Adam Jacobi, National Forensic League Education and Programs Coordinator, Ripon College Assistant Director of Forensics, and former WDCA president.

The tournament was held December 11-12, 2010 at Ripon College, hosted by Professor Deano Pape, Director of Forensics. 248 contestants from 30 schools participated at the tournament. Following are results highlights; full results are available online.

The 2010 tournament will be remembered for the severe blizzard that pummeled the upper Midwest. Ripon's snowfall was by one report, measured at 12 inches over the course of the two days. Tournament officials decided to delay the start of the second day of the tournament, truncating the number of rounds to four in the Varsity Four Person division (instead of six); five preliminary rounds and semifinals in the Two Person division (instead of six rounds plus quarterfinals); five preliminary rounds and quarterfinals in Public Forum (instead of six rounds plus octafinals); and five preliminary rounds in Lincoln Douglas Debate (instead of six). Several schools who went home did not return to continue competing on Sunday.
